Chic Renovation near Church Hill's Libby Hill Park

Fabulously located only one-half block from Libby Hill Park and the historic view that gave Richmond its name, this turn-of-the-century brick house epitomizes Church Hill's urban chic. A 2006 renovation preserved original details such as heart pine floors, wood mouldings, pocket doors, and a sensational oak mantel and staircase. But the costliest items—the systems, roofing, baths and kitchen—were replaced. Windows that run along a quaint cobblestone alley bring in lots of light. A side gate off that alley leads to a fenced yard with patio. Inside the 2-story brick house are 3 bedrooms, one and a half baths, 4 distinctive fireplaces, a sleek granite and



stainless kitchen, and rear staircase. Nothing is left to be done, but to enjoy the convenience of living on a most desirable block minutes from interstate travel, airport and entertainment venues.
